1. On page 182, between lines 15 and 16, insert the following new item with the appropriation under the General Fund column:

"(74) DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH 18,450.0

For early childhood development programs through fiscal year 2022. The department of health shall collaborate with the children, youth and families department and the public education department to report to the governor's office and the legislature by July 1, 2020 through 2023 regarding the impact additional funding for early childhood development programs has in improving educational and psychosocial outcomes for eligible children."

2. On page 183, between lines 3 and 4, insert the following new item with the appropriation under the General Fund column:

"(78) CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES DEPARTMENT 75,900.0

For early childhood development programs through fiscal year 2022. The children, youth and families department shall collaborate with the department of health and the public education department to report to the governor's office and the legislature by July 1, 2020 through 2023 regarding the impact additional funding for early childhood development programs has in improving educational and psychosocial outcomes for eligible children."

3. On page 185, between lines 13 and 14, insert the following new item with the appropriation under the General Fund column:
