17	SECTION 1. Section 30-7-2.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1987,
18	Chapter 232, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:
19	"30-7-2.1. UNLAWFUL CARRYING OF A DEADLY WEAPON ON SCHOOL
20	PREMISES
21	A. Unlawful carrying of a deadly weapon on school
22	premises consists of carrying a deadly weapon on school
23	premises except by:
24	(1) a peace officer <u>or a retired peace</u>
25	<u>officer;</u>

2	(3) a student, instructor or other school-
3	authorized personnel engaged in army, navy, marine corps or air
4	force reserve officer training corps programs or state-

8	carrying of a deadly weapon; [or]
9	(5) a person older than nineteen years of age

21	high school in or on which school or school-related activities
22	are being operated under the supervision of a local school

24	[(2)] <u>(b)</u> any other public buildings or
25	grounds, including playing fields and parking areas that are
