- 3. On page 7, line 7, strike the period and insert in lieu thereof "; and".
- 4. On page 7, between lines 7 and 8, insert the following new paragraph:
- "(7) "trauma-informed policy" means a program or system that realizes the widespread impact of trauma and understands potential paths for recovery; recognizes the signs and symptoms of trauma in clients, families, staff and others involved with the system; responds by fully integrating knowledge about trauma into policies, procedures and practices; and seeks to actively resist retraumatization.".
- 5. On page 7, line 13, strike "complainant-centered" and insert in lieu thereof "trauma-informed".
- 6. On page 7, line 17, after "volunteer", strike the comma and insert in lieu thereof "or".
  - 7. On page 7, lines 17 and 18, strike "or regent".
  - 8. On page 12, line 9, strike "and".

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- 9. On page 12, line 12, strike the period and closing quotation mark and insert in lieu thereof "; and".
- 10. On page 12, between lines 12 and 13, insert the following new paragraph:
- "(6) "trauma-informed policy" means a program or system that realizes the widespread impact of trauma and understands potential paths for recovery; recognizes the signs and symptoms of trauma in clients, families, staff and others involved with the system; responds by fully integrating knowledge about trauma into policies, procedures and practices; and seeks to actively resist retraumatization."".
