18	A. No state agency employee shall disclose
19	sensitive personal information acquired by virtue of the
20	employee's position with a state agency to anyone outside the
21	state agency except when such disclosure is necessary to carry
22	out a function of the state agency, to comply with an order of
23	a court of this state or of the United States, in response to a
24	subpoena, as permitted by 66-2-7.1 NMSA 1978 and as required by
25	federal law.

1	B. As used in this section, "sensitive personal
2	information" means:
3	(1) "genetic information" as defined in
4	Subsection D of Section 24-21-2 NMSA 1978;
5	(2) "protected personal identifier
6	information" as defined in Subsection E of Section 14-2-6 NMSA
7	1978;
8	(3) "personal information" as defined in
9	Subsection F of Section 66-1-4.14 NMSA 1978;
10	(4) a person's status as a recipient of public
11	assistance or as a crime victim; and
12	(5) a person's sexual orientation, physical or
13	mental disability, immigration status, national origin or
14	religion."
15	SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATEThe effective date of the
16	provisions of this act is July 1, 2019.
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
