| 25 | The design of the [reading] <u>literacy and biliteracy</u> initiative |
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1 shall be based upon quality, scientifically based [reading] 2 literacy and biliteracy research that has been shown to improve reading, writing and spelling proficiency and shall include the 3 4 following: [consistent] informative assessment and 5 (1)evaluation of student [reading] <u>literacy and biliteracy</u> levels; 6 7 (2) appropriate professional staff development to assist licensed school employees in the instruction of 8 9 [reading] literacy and biliteracy; (3) extra time in the student's day or year 10 for implementation of [reading] literacy and biliteracy 11 12 programs; [(4) rewards provided to teachers and other 13 applicable licensed school employees in public schools that 14 improve student reading proficiency] and 15 [(5)] (4) criteria for public schools to 16 establish an individualized [reading] literacy and biliteracy 17 plan for students who fail to meet grade level [reading] 18 literacy and biliteracy proficiency standards. 19 20 Β.
