16	SECTION 1. [NEW MATERIAL] EQUAL ACCESS TO PUBLIC BABY
17	CHANGING FACILITIES
18	A. As used in this section:
19	(1) "baby changing facility" means a table or
20	other device suitable for changing the diaper of a child age
21	three or under;
22	(2) "division" means the construction
23	industries division of the regulation and licensing department;

25	(3) "public accommodation" means:

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1	(a) an inn, hotel, motel or other place
2	of lodging except for an establishment that is located within a
3	building that contains not more than five rooms for rent or
4	hire and that is actually occupied by the proprietor of such
5	establishment as a residence;
6	(b) a restaurant, bar or other
7	establishment serving food or drink;
8	(c) a motion picture house, theater,
9	concert hall, stadium or other place of exhibition or
10	entertainment;
11	(d) an auditorium, convention center,
12	lecture hall or other place of public gathering;
13	(e) a bakery, grocery store, clothing
14	store, shopping center or other sales or rental establishment;
15	(f) a laundromat, bank, barber shop,
16	beauty shop, travel service, funeral parlor, gas station,

9	B. No later than January 1, 2020, the division
10	shall develop and adopt rules governing baby changing
11	facilities for restrooms in a place of public accommodation.
12	C. A place of public accommodation shall provide a
13	baby changing facility in restrooms for men and in restrooms
14	for women. This requirement applies only under the following
15	circumstances:
16	(1) when there is construction of a new
17	restroom; and
18	(2) to the extent it may be implemented in
19	compliance with local, state and federal laws regarding access
20	for persons with disabilities and with existing fire, health
21	and safety standards.
22	D. The requirements of Subsection C of this section
23	shall not apply to a restroom in a place of public
24	accommodation that:
25	(1) is not available or accessible for public

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(j) a nursery, elementary, secondary,

use; or

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(2) contains clear and conspicuous signage indicating where a restroom with a baby changing facility is located on the same floor of such place of public accommodation.

- This section shall not be construed to create a private right of action for failure to comply with the provisions of this section or rules adopted in accordance with this section.
- The division may assess a fine, not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), for violation of the provisions of this section or rules adopted in accordance with this section. Fines shall be credited to the current school fund as provided in Article 12, Section 4 of the constitution of New Mexico.

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
