AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH; REQUIRING HEALTH FACILITIES TO GRANT

CERTAIN PRIVILEGES TO CERTIFIED NURSE PRACTITIONERS AND

CERTIFIED NURSE-MIDWIVES IN PARITY WITH PHYSICIAN PRIVILEGES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

- SECTION 1. [NEW MATERIAL] HEALTH FACILITIES--CERTIFIED NURSE PRACTITIONERS--CERTIFIED NURSE-MIDWIVES--PRIVILEGES--PARITY WITH PHYSICIANS.--
- A. Unless required by federal law, a health facility shall establish the same criteria for granting patient admitting or discharge privileges or in authorizing continuing patient care for certified nurse practitioners, certified nurse-midwives and clinical nurse specialists as the health facility has established for physicians.
- B. A health facility shall ensure that certified .211684.1

nurse practitioners, certified nurse-midwives and clinical
nurse specialists acting in accordance with these
professionals' respective scopes of practice under New Mexico
law are:

- eligible to serve on the health facility's medical staff;
- (2) credentialed under the same procedures as the health facility has established for physicians; and
- (3) authorized to conduct peer review of their professional colleagues.

## C. As used in this section:

- "certified nurse-midwife" means an individual licensed as a registered nurse pursuant to the Nursing Practice Act and licensed by the department of health as a certified nurse-midwife;
- "certified nurse practitioner" means a registered nurse who is licensed by the board of nursing for advanced practice as a certified nurse practitioner pursuant to the Nursing Practice Act;
- (3) "health facility" means a health facility licensed by the department of health pursuant to the Public Health Act; and
- (4) "physician" means an individual licensed to practice as a medical doctor or an osteopathic physician.
