BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the Procurement Code is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] PUBLIC CONTRACTS--SERVICES--MINIMUM WAGE
INCREASES.--

- A. Beginning July 1, 2019, a state agency or local public body that contracts for services shall include in the terms of that contract:
 - (1) a provision for increasing reimbursement

to the contractor in direct proportion to any increase in the state minimum wage pursuant to the Minimum Wage Act; and

- (2) a requirement that individuals employed pursuant to that contract shall receive wage increases in accordance with and concurrent with increases in the state minimum wage pursuant to the Minimum Wage Act.
 - B. As used in this section:
- (1) "contract" means any agreement for the procurement of services; and
- (2) "services" means the furnishing of labor, time or effort by a contractor not involving the delivery of a specific end product other than reports and other materials that are merely incidental to the required performance."
