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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	SECTION 1. Section 61-13-14 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1970,
17	Chapter 61, Section 13) is amended to read:
18	"61-13-14. PENALTIESIt shall be a misdemeanor for
19	[any] <u>a</u> person to:
20	A. sell or fraudulently obtain or furnish [any] <u>a</u>
21	license or aid or abet in the obtaining or furnishing of [any]
22	a license under the Nursing Home Administrators Act;
23	B. practice as a nursing home administrator, under
24	cover of [any] <u>a</u> license or registration illegally or
25	fraudulently obtained or unlawfully issued;

1	C. practice as a nursing home administrator or use
2	in connection with [his] <u>the person's</u> name [any] <u>a</u> designation
3	tending to imply that [he] <u>the person</u> is a nursing home

6	Administrators Act; [or]
7	D. practice as a nursing home administrator without
8	a valid license or during the time [his] <u>the person's</u> license

12	in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of this 2019

14	SECTION 2. A new section of the Nursing Home
15	Administrators Act is enacted to read:
16	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] NURSING HOME CLOSURENOTICE
17	A. A nursing home administrator shall:
18	(1) submit to the department of health, the
19	office of the state long-term care ombudsman, residents of the
20	nursing home and the legal representatives of nursing home
21	residents or other responsible parties written notification of
22	an impending closure at least ninety days before the date of
23	closure. The notice shall include a plan, that has been
24	approved by the department of health, for:
25	(a) the transfer and adequate relocation
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1 of the residents of the nursing home by a date specified by the 2 department of health before closure; and 3 (b) assurances that the residents will be transferred to the most appropriate facility or other 4 setting in terms of quality, services and location, taking into 5 consideration the needs, choice and best interests of each 6 7 resident; and ensure that the nursing home does not 8 (2) admit any new residents on or after the date on which written 9 notification of closure is submitted pursuant to Paragraph (1) 10 of this subsection. 11 12 Β.
