- (1) the expenses of the commission up to five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for carrying out its duties,

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including the costs of field hearings, hiring technical experts and other expenses as necessary;

(2) planning grants to local public agencies of up to one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) per agency for the purposes of studying the need for and the costs and benefits of developing physical improvements, facilities, marketing and interpretive services in an area to enhance the visitor experience and increase tourism; provided that at least fifty percent of the total cost of a study is provided in non-state money; and

(3) loans to local public agencies for the design, construction and installation of physical improvements and facilities.".,
