18	"6-26-4. BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CAPITAL FUND
19	A. The "behavioral health capital fund" is created
20	as a revolving fund in the authority. The fund shall consist
21	of appropriations, loan repayments, gifts, grants, donations
22	and interest earned on investment of the fund. Money in the
23	fund shall not revert at the end of a fiscal year.
24	B. Money in the fund is appropriated to the
25	authority for the purpose of making loans to eligible entities
