18	"9-27-16. SERVICE CHARGE
19	A. The department of information technology shall
20	charge a fee to the state or any officer, agency, department,
21	division, board or commission of the state for any services
22	rendered in the exercise of its supervisory control. <u>Beginning</u>
23	five years after such a fee is incurred, the obligation to pay
24	it is discharged, and the department shall not attempt to
25	<u>collect it.</u>
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	1	B. Fees shall be fixed by the secretary of
	2	information technology.
	3	C. Income from fees collected shall be deposited to
	4	the credit of the department of information technology and used
	5	to carry out the duties of the department.
	6	D. The department of information technology may
	7	provide two-way radio services to counties and municipalities
	8	at the same rates charged state agencies."
	9	SECTION 2. APPLICABILITYThe provisions of this act
	10	apply to a fee incurred before, on or after the effective date
	11	of this act.
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
