11 RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; REQUIRING THAT THE BRAIN INJURY
12 SERVICES FEE BE MANDATORY FOR TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 SECTION 1. Section 66-8-116.3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1989,
16 Chapter 318, Section 35 and Laws 1989, Chapter 319, Section 14
17 and also Laws 1989, Chapter 320, Section 5, as amended) is
18 amended to read:

19 "66-8-116.3. PENALTY ASSESSMENT MISDEMEANORS--ADDITIONAL
20 FEES.--In addition to the penalty assessment established for
21 each penalty assessment misdemeanor, there shall be assessed:

22 A. in a county without a metropolitan court, twenty
23 dollars (\$20.00) to help defray the costs of local government
24 corrections;

25 B. a court automation fee of ten dollars (\$10.00);

1 C. a traffic safety fee of three dollars (\$3.00),
2 which shall be credited to the traffic safety education and
3 enforcement fund;

4 D. a judicial education fee of three dollars
5 (\$3.00), which shall be credited to the judicial education
6 fund;

7 E. a jury and witness fee of five dollars (\$5.00),
8 which shall be credited to the jury and witness fee fund;

9 F. a juvenile adjudication fee of one dollar
10 (\$1.00), which shall be credited to the juvenile adjudication
11 fund;

12 G. a brain injury services fee of five dollars
13 (\$5.00), which shall be collected and shall not be waived,
14 deferred or suspended and which shall be credited to the brain
15 injury services fund; and

16 H. a court facilities fee as follows:
17 in a county with a metropolitan court \$24.00;
18 in any other county 10.00.
