the department conduct periodic reviews of and 8 C. 9 collect data related to the program and prepare an annual 10 report on the program, including any recommendations for possible improvements to the program." 11

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2019.
