AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE SYMBOLS; DECLARING "CHILE VERDE ROCK" AS THE OFFICIAL STATE CHILE SONG.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 12, Article 3 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] STATE CHILE SONG.--The words and music of the song "Chile Verde Rock", written by Uvaldo Olonia, are declared as the official state chile song subject to the state of New Mexico acquiring ownership and copyright or a perpetual license for use of this song. The words of the state chile song are as follows:
