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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	SECTION 1. Section 10-11-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1987,
18	Chapter 253, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:
19	"10-11-2. DEFINITIONSAs used in the Public Employees
20	Retirement Act:
21	A. "accumulated member contributions" means the
22	amounts deducted from the salary of a member and credited to
23	the member's individual account, together with interest, if
24	any, credited to that account;
25	B. "affiliated public employer" means the state and
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any public employer affiliated with the association as provided in the Public Employees Retirement Act, but does not include an employer pursuant to the Magistrate Retirement Act, the Judicial Retirement Act or the Educational Retirement Act;

C. "association" means the public employees retirement association established under the Public Employees Retirement Act;

D. "disability retired member" means a retired member who is receiving a pension pursuant to the disability retirement provisions of the Public Employees Retirement Act;

E. "disability retirement pension" means the pension paid pursuant to the disability retirement provisions of the Public Employees Retirement Act;

F. "educational retirement system" means that retirement system provided for in the Educational Retirement Act;

G. "employee" means any employee of an affiliated
public employer;

H. "federal social security program" means that program or those programs created and administered pursuant to the act of congress approved August 14, 1935, Chapter 531, 49 Stat. 620, as that act may be amended;

I. "final average salary" means the final average salary calculated in accordance with the provisions of the applicable coverage plan;

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1 J. "form of payment" means the applicable form of 2 payment of a pension provided for in Section 10-11-117 NMSA 3 1978;

"former member" means a person who was К. previously employed by an affiliated public employer, who has terminated that employment and who has received a refund of 7 member contributions;

"fund" means the funds included under the Public 8 τ. 9 Employees Retirement Act;

"member" means a currently employed, 10 М. contributing employee of an affiliated public employer, or a 11 12 person who has been but is not currently employed by an affiliated public employer, who has not retired and who has not 13 received a refund of member contributions; "member" also 14 includes the following: 15

(1) "adult correctional officer member" means a member who is employed as an adult correctional officer or an adult correctional officer specialist by a state correctional facility of the corrections department or its successor agency;

(2)"juvenile correctional officer member" means a member who is employed as a juvenile correctional officer by the children, youth and families department or its successor agency;

"municipal detention officer member" means (3) a member who is employed by an affiliated public employer other .211347.1

"pension" means a series of monthly payments to 22 a retired member or survivor beneficiary as provided in the 23 Public Employees Retirement Act; 24 "public employer" means the state, any Ρ. 25

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1 municipality, city, county, metropolitan arroyo flood control 2 authority, economic development district, special hospital district that opts to participate in the state system for 3 public employee retirement, regional housing authority, soil 4 and water conservation district, entity created pursuant to a 5 joint powers agreement, council of government, conservancy 6 7 district, irrigation district, water and sanitation district, 8 water district and metropolitan water board, including the 9 boards, departments, bureaus and agencies of a public employer, so long as these entities fall within the meaning of 10 governmental plan as that term is used in Section 414(d) of the 11 12 Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended;

Q. "refund beneficiary" means a person designated by the member, in writing, in the form prescribed by the association, as the person who would be refunded the member's accumulated member contributions payable if the member dies and no survivor pension is payable or who would receive the difference between pension paid and accumulated member contributions if the retired member dies before receiving in pension payments the amount of the accumulated member contributions;

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R. "retire" means to:

(1) terminate employment with all employers
covered by any state system or the educational retirement
system; and

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(2) receive a pension from a state system or the educational retirement system;

S. "retired member" means a person who has met all requirements for retirement and who is receiving a pension from the fund;

T. "retirement board" means the retirement board provided for in the Public Employees Retirement Act;

"salary" means the base salary or wages paid a U. member, including longevity pay, for personal services rendered an affiliated public employer. "Salary" shall not include overtime pay, allowances for housing, clothing, equipment or travel, payments for unused sick leave, unless the unused sick leave payment is made through continuation of the member on the regular payroll for the period represented by that payment, and any other form of remuneration not specifically designated by law as included in salary for Public Employees Retirement Act purposes. Salary in excess of the limitations set forth in Section 401(a)(17) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, shall be disregarded. The limitation on compensation for eligible employees shall not be less than the amount that was allowed to be taken into account under the state retirement system acts in effect on July 1, 1993. For purposes of this subsection, "eligible employee" means an individual who was a member of a state system before the first plan year beginning after December 31, 1995;

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v. "state system" means the retirement programs 2 provided for in the Public Employees Retirement Act, the Magistrate Retirement Act and the Judicial Retirement Act; 3

"state retirement system acts" means 4 W. 5 collectively the Public Employees Retirement Act, the Magistrate Retirement Act, the Judicial Retirement Act and the 6 7 Volunteer Firefighters Retirement Act; and

"survivor beneficiary" means a person who 8 Χ. 9 receives a pension or who has been designated to be paid a pension as a result of the death of a member or retired 10 member." 11

SECTION 2. A new section of the Public Employees Retirement Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] SPECIAL HOSPITAL DISTRICT--OPTING INTO PUBLIC EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT COVERAGE.--Upon approval by the special hospital district's board of trustees, a special hospital district may elect to participate in the state system for public employee retirement pursuant to the Public Employees Retirement Act."

**SECTION 3.** APPROPRIATION. -- Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the public employees retirement association for expenditure in fiscal year 2020 to cover the administrative costs related to the classification of special hospital district employees as public employees pursuant to the Public Employees Retirement Act, in .211347.1
