12	SECTION 1. EQUAL ACCESS TO PUBLIC BABY CHANGING

14	A. No later than January 1, 2020, the division
15	shall develop and adopt rules governing baby changing
16	facilities for restrooms in a place of public accommodation.
17	B. A place of public accommodation shall provide a
18	baby changing facility in each restroom located in the place
19	of public accommodation under the following circumstances:
20	(1) when there is construction of a new
21	restroom; and
22	(2) to the extent it may be implemented in

compliance with local, state and federal laws regarding

health and safety standards.

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C. The requirements of Subsection B of this section shall not apply to a restroom in a place of public accommodation that:

- (1) is not available or accessible for public use; or
- (2) contains clear and conspicuous signage indicating where a restroom with a baby changing facility is located on the same floor of such place of public accommodation.
- D. All drawings, specifications and other submittal documents as to new construction of a place of public accommodation shall incorporate the requirements of this section when submitted to the appropriate authority having jurisdiction for plan review. The authority having jurisdiction shall not approve drawings and submittal documents for new construction of a place of public accommodation unless drawings, specifications and other submittal documents comply with the provisions of this section. No certificate of occupancy shall be issued for new construction of a place of public accommodation unless fully compliant with the provisions of this section.
- E. This section shall not be construed to create a private right of action for failure to comply with the provisions of this section or rules adopted in accordance with this section.

## 1 F. As used in this section: 2 "authority having jurisdiction" means (1) 3 the state or a municipality, county or other political subdivision that has a full-service building department 4 5 employing a full-time certified building official and has permitting, inspection and enforcement authority over the 6 general construction, electrical and mechanical-plumbing 7 trades within its jurisdiction; 8 "baby changing facility" means a table 9 10 or other device suitable for changing the diaper of a child age three or under; 11 "department" means the regulation and 12 (3) licensing department; 13 "division" means the construction 14 15 industries division of the regulation and licensing department; and 16 (5) "public accommodation" means: 17 an inn, hotel, motel or other place 18 of lodging except for an establishment that is located within 19 20 a building that contains not more than five rooms for rent or hire and that is actually occupied by the proprietor of such 21 establishment as a residence; 22 a restaurant, bar or other 23 establishment serving food or drink; 24
