10	A. Unless required by federal law, a health
11	facility shall establish the same criteria for granting
12	patient admitting or discharge privileges or in authorizing
13	continuing patient care for certified nurse practitioners,
14	certified nurse-midwives and clinical nurse specialists as
15	the health facility has established for physicians.
16	B. A health facility shall ensure that certified
17	nurse practitioners, certified nurse-midwives and clinical
18	nurse specialists acting in accordance with these
19	professionals' respective scopes of practice under New Mexico
20	law are:
21	(1) eligible to serve on the health

facility's medical staff;

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(3) authorized to conduct peer review of

as the health facility has established for physicians; and

(2) credentialed under the same procedures

2	C. As used in this section:	
3	(1) "certified nurse-midwife" means an	
4	individual licensed as a registered nurse pursuant to the	
5	Nursing Practice Act and licensed by the department of health	
6	as a certified nurse-midwife;	
7	(2) "certified nurse practitioner" means a	
8	registered nurse who is licensed by the board of nursing for	
9	advanced practice as a certified nurse practitioner pursuant	
10	to the Nursing Practice Act;	
11	(3) "clinical nurse specialist" means a	
12	registered nurse who is licensed by the board of nursing for	
13	advanced practice as a clinical nurse specialist and whose	
14	name and pertinent information are entered on the list of	
15	clinical nurse specialists maintained by the board of	
16	nursing;	
17	(4) "health facility" means a health	
18	facility licensed by the department of health pursuant to the	
19	Public Health Act; and	
20	(5) "physician" means an individual licensed	
21	to practice as a medical doctor or an osteopathic physician.	
22	SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE The effective date of the	
23	provisions of this act is July 1, 2020	
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
