5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
6	SECTION 1. Section 66-5-30 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978,
7	Chapter 35, Section 252, as amended) is amended to read:
8	"66-5-30. AUTHORITY OF DIVISION TO SUSPEND OR REVOKE
9	LICENSE
10	A. The division may suspend the instruction
11	permit, driver's license or provisional license of a driver
12	without preliminary hearing upon a showing by its records or
13	other sufficient evidence, including information provided to
14	the state pursuant to an intergovernmental agreement
15	authorized by Section 66-5-27.1 NMSA 1978, that the licensee:
16	(1) has been convicted of an offense for
17	which mandatory revocation of license is required upon
18	conviction;
19	(2) has been convicted as a driver in an
20	accident resulting in the death or personal injury of another
21	or serious property damage;
22	(3) has been convicted with such frequency
23	of offenses against traffic laws or rules governing motor
24	vehicles as to indicate a disrespect for traffic laws and a
25	disregard for the safety of other persons on the highways;
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1 is an habitually reckless or negligent (4) 2 driver of a motor vehicle; 3 (5) is incompetent to drive a motor vehicle; (6) has permitted an unlawful or fraudulent 4 5 use of the license; has been convicted of an offense in 6 (7) 7 another state or tribal jurisdiction that if committed within this state's jurisdiction would be grounds for suspension or 8 revocation of the license; 9 10 has violated provisions stipulated by a (8) district court in limitation of certain driving privileges; 11 12 or 13 (9) has accumulated seven points, but less than eleven points, and when the division has received a 14 15 recommendation from a municipal or magistrate judge that the 16 license be suspended for a period not to exceed three months. Β. The division may issue an administrative 17 suspension of the instruction permit, driver's license or 18 provisional license of a driver without preliminary hearing 19 20 upon a showing by its records or other sufficient evidence, including information provided to the state pursuant to an 21 intergovernmental agreement authorized by Section 66-5-27.1 22 NMSA 1978, that the licensee has failed to: 23 24 (1)fulfill a signed promise to appear or notice to appear in court as evidenced by notice from a state HB 427/a 25 Page 2

court or tribal court, whenever appearance is required by law or by the court as a consequence of a charge or conviction under the Motor Vehicle Code or pursuant to the laws of the tribe;

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(2) pay a penalty assessment within thirtydays of the date of issuance by the state or a tribe; or

7 (3) comply with the terms of a citation
8 issued in a foreign jurisdiction that is a party to the
9 Nonresident Violator Compact and that has notified the
10 department of the failure in accordance with the Nonresident
11 Violator Compact.

C. If a person whose license was issued by a 12 13 jurisdiction outside New Mexico that is a party to the Nonresident Violator Compact fails to comply with the terms 14 15 of a citation issued in New Mexico, the department shall notify that other jurisdiction of the failure and that 16 jurisdiction shall initiate a license suspension action in 17 accordance with the provisions of Article IV of the 18 Nonresident Violator Compact. 19

D. Upon suspending the license of a person as authorized in this section, the division shall immediately notify the licensee in writing of the licensee's right to a hearing before the administrative hearings office and, upon the licensee's request, shall notify the administrative hearings office. The administrative hearings office shall

1 schedule the hearing to take place as early as practicable, 2 but within no more than twenty days, not counting Saturdays, 3 Sundays and legal holidays after receipt of the request. The 4 hearing shall be held in the county in which the licensee 5 resides unless the hearing officer and the licensee agree that the hearing may be held in some other county; provided 6 that the hearing request is received within twenty days from 7 the date that the suspension was deposited in the United 8 States mail. The hearing officer may, in the hearing 9 officer's discretion, extend the twenty-day period. 10 The hearing shall be held as provided in the Administrative 11 Hearings Office Act. After the hearing, the hearing officer 12 shall either rescind the order of suspension or continue, 13 modify or extend the suspension of the license or revoke the 14 15 license."

SECTION 2. Section 66-5-39 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978, Chapter 35, Section 261, as amended) is amended to read:

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"66-5-39. DRIVING WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED--PENALTIES.--

A. A person who drives a motor vehicle on any
public highway of this state at a time when the person's
privilege to do so is suspended and who knows or should have
known that the person's license was suspended is guilty of a
misdemeanor and may be punished pursuant to Subsection B of
Section 66-8-7 NMSA 1978 or for no more than ninety days of
participation in a certified alternative sentencing program.

When a person pays any or all of the cost of participating in a certified alternative sentencing program, the court may apply that payment as a deduction to any fine imposed by the court. Any municipal ordinance prohibiting driving with a suspended license shall provide penalties no less stringent than provided in this section.

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In addition to any other penalties imposed 7 Β. 8 pursuant to the provisions of this section, when a person is convicted pursuant to the provisions of this section or a 9 10 municipal ordinance that prohibits driving on a suspended license, the motor vehicle the person was driving may be 11 immobilized by an immobilization device for thirty days, 12 unless immobilization of the motor vehicle poses an imminent 13 danger to the health, safety or employment of the convicted 14 15 person's immediate family or the family of the owner of the motor vehicle. The convicted person shall bear the cost of 16 17 immobilizing the motor vehicle."

18 SECTION 3. A new Section 66-5-39.2 NMSA 1978 is enacted 19 to read:

"66-5-39.2. DRIVING WHILE LICENSE ADMINISTRATIVELY
SUSPENDED.--A person who drives a motor vehicle on any public
highway of this state at a time when the person's privilege
to do so is administratively suspended is guilty of a penalty
assessment misdemeanor and may be punished in accordance with
the provisions of Section 66-8-116 NMSA 1978."

14	B. The term "penalty assessment misdemeanor" does
15	not include a violation that has caused or contributed to the
16	cause of an accident resulting in injury or death to a
17	person.
18	C. When an alleged violator of a penalty
19	assessment misdemeanor elects to accept a notice to appear in
20	lieu of a notice of penalty assessment, a fine imposed upon
21	later conviction shall not exceed the penalty assessment
22	established for the particular penalty assessment misdemeanor
23	and probation imposed upon a suspended or deferred sentence
24	shall not exceed ninety days.
25	D. The penalty assessment for speeding in

violation of Paragraph (5) of Subsection A of Section 66-7-301 NMSA 1978 is twice the penalty assessment established in Subsection A of this section for the equivalent miles per hour over the speed limit.

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E. Upon a second conviction for operation without a permit for excessive size or weight pursuant to Section 66-7-413 NMSA 1978, the penalty assessment shall be two hundred fifty dollars (\$250). Upon a third or subsequent conviction, the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars (\$500).

F. Upon a second conviction for transport of a reducible load with a permit for excessive size or weight pursuant to Subsection N of Section 66-7-413 NMSA 1978 more than six miles from a port-of-entry facility on the border with Mexico, the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars (\$500). Upon a third or subsequent conviction, the penalty assessment shall be one thousand dollars (\$1,000)."

18 SECTION 5. Section 66-8-126 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978,
19 Chapter 35, Section 534) is amended to read:

"66-8-126. FAILURE TO OBEY NOTICE TO APPEAR.--

A. It is a penalty assessment misdemeanor for a person to violate that person's written promise to appear in court given to an officer upon issuance of a uniform traffic citation regardless of the disposition of the charge for which the citation was issued.
