SB 5 Page 2 districts. The appointed members shall be qualified by no less than ten years' experience with New Mexico water resources. A member who changes political party affiliation shall be deemed to have resigned, and a person shall not be qualified for appointment if the person has changed party affiliation in the previous two years.

C. Appointed members of the commission shall serve
for staggered terms of four years; provided that of the
initial members, two members shall serve for one year, two
members shall serve for two years, two members shall serve
for three years and two members shall serve for four years.
Initial terms shall be decided by drawing lots.

A member may be removed from the commission by 13 D. the original appointing authority of that member for failure 14 15 to attend three consecutive meetings or for other cause in 16 the same manner as provided for removal of members of boards of regents under Article 12, Section 13 of the constitution 17 of New Mexico. A vacancy occurring other than by expiration 18 of the term shall be filled in the same manner as the 19 20 original appointment for the remainder of the unexpired term.

E. The commission shall elect a chair and vice chair as provided by rule, and the state engineer shall be the secretary. A commission member shall not hold any employment in a political party.

3 SECTION 2. TEMPORARY PROVISION--INITIAL APPOINTMENTS TO 4 INTERSTATE STREAM COMMISSION. -- Members of the interstate 5 stream commission serving as of July 1, 2019 shall continue 6 in their positions until their replacements have been appointed. Current members who meet the qualifications of 7 8 the positions specified in Section 72-14-1 NMSA 1978 may 9 be appointed for new terms. A member appointed before 10 January 1, 2020 pursuant to this act shall take office immediately, serve the remainder of the year and serve for a 11 term beginning January 1, 2020 and ending December 31 in the 12 year for that position as determined by lot in accordance 13 with Subsection C of Section 72-14-1 NMSA 1978. 14

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2019._________SB 5
