The original issuance and renewal of licenses 7 Α. to practice as a barber, hairstylist, cosmetologist, 8 instructor, esthetician, manicurist-pedicurist or 9 10 electrologist shall be for a period of two years or less from the date of issuance. If the licensee fails to renew the 11 license for the next two-year period, the license is void; 12 provided the license may be restored at any time during the 13 year following expiration upon the payment of the appropriate 14 15 fee and a late charge not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) 16 as set forth by board rules. If the licensee fails to restore the license within one year following its expiration, the 17 licensee may request restoration of the license pursuant to 18 rules promulgated by the board. 19

B. The original issuance and annual renewal of
licenses to operate an establishment or school shall be for a
period of twelve months or less following the issuance of the
license. If the licensee fails to renew the license within
thirty days after its expiration, the license is void, and, to
again obtain a license, an application, required SB 109
