DECLARING MARCH 1, 2019 "FOSTER PARENT APPRECIATION, ADVOCACY AND AWARENESS DAY" IN THE SENATE.

WHEREAS, according to the children, youth and families department, in fiscal year 2018, there were two thousand five hundred thirty-one children in foster care; and

WHEREAS, foster care parents participated in three hundred eleven finalized adoptions; and

WHEREAS, foster care parents are ready to receive a child at a moment's notice, without any previous knowledge or information about the child or for how long the child will need their care; and

WHEREAS, foster care parents exemplify selflessness and community by building positive connections and experiences for foster care children by doing their best to provide for the stability and security of those children; and

WHEREAS, foster care parents open their homes and their hearts to children who need love and support, while

4	care realize they are not alone and that others care for

7	self-esteem and confidence and provide structure that will

9	WHEREAS, foster care parents have the joy and privilege
10	of parenting and learning from children who did not decide to
11	be placed under the state's care, but like all children, have
12	so much to offer;
13	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE
14	STATE OF NEW MEXICO that March 1, 2019 be declared
15	"Foster Parent Appreciation, Advocacy and Awareness Day" in
