## SUMMARY

## Synopsis of Bill

The House Transportation, Public Works, and Capital Improvements Committee substitute for House Bill 306 creates a new section of the Motor Vehicle Code providing a Special registration plate for the national FFA organization, formerly known as Future Farmers of America.

## FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The plate will have an initial fee of $\$ 35$ and then $\$ 25$ for annual renewals. TRD will retain $\$ 10$ of the initial fee for the manufacture and issuance of the special plate. $\$ 25$ from the initial registration and from each renewal will be transferred to the Board of Regents of New Mexico State University for the Agricultural Experiment Station to fund statewide programs for active FFA chapters. Revenue estimates assume 100 plates annually.

## SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

TRD currently has 153 separate accounts for motor vehicles, boats, off-road vehicles, and government vehicles. The majority of these accounts are for specialty plates for various organizations and programs. These plates generate very little revenue for the sponsoring organizations.

The cost to design and implement a new plate is passed on to the requesting entity who is required to pay for an initial order of 100 plates. Total cost is $\$ 600$ : $\$ 100$ to design and $\$ 500$ for the initial order of 100 plates.

## ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS

TRD assesses there will be minimal administrative impact for MVD requiring revision the policy manual and procedural requirements for processing. SHARE will need to be modified to account for the new fees and distributions. There will be a modest impact on the Information and Technology Division to complete, test and implement changes at a cost of $\$ 33.6$ thousand and approximately 12 weeks to complete.
