SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 620 modifies 20-7-5 NMSA 1978 to allow members of the Civil Air Patrol to use military leave pursuant to 20-4-7 NMSA 1978 for "official duties as assigned by the director of the civil air patrol division of the department of military affairs or an incident commander of an active mission" instead of strictly for "search and rescue missions."

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

This bill will not have a fiscal impact to state agencies.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

This bill will allow the Civil Air Patrol to utilize military leave for other official duties not specific to search and rescue missions.
