## A MEMORIAL

DECLARING MARCH 1, 2019 "FOSTER PARENT APPRECIATION, ADVOCACY AND AWARENESS DAY" IN THE SENATE.

WHEREAS, foster care parents participated in three hundred eleven finalized adoptions; and

WHEREAS, foster care parents are ready to receive a child .211908.1

at a moment's notice, without any previous knowledge or information about the child or for how long the child will need their care; and

WHEREAS, foster care parents exemplify selflessness and community by building positive connections and experiences for foster care children by doing their best to provide for the stability and security of those children; and

WHEREAS, foster care parents open their homes and their hearts to children who need love and support, while respecting and fostering connections to the children's culture, religion and community; and

WHEREAS, foster care parents help children in foster care realize they are not alone and that others care for them; and

WHEREAS, foster care parents help children build selfesteem and confidence and provide structure that will contribute to healthy and engaging lives; and

WHEREAS, foster care parents have the joy and privilege of parenting and learning from children who did not decide to be placed under the state's care, but like all children, have so much to offer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE

OF NEW MEXICO that March 1, 2019 be declared "Foster Parent

Appreciation, Advocacy and Awareness Day" in the senate; and
