counties and communities with low-income populations where the need for emergency medical services funding is especially acute, do not generate enough tax revenue to provide adequate funding to sustain reliable and viable emergency medical services; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the state and its residents that rural counties and communities have the capacity to provide quality and efficient emergency medical services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the emergency medical systems bureau of the department of health be requested to initiate a study to examine regulations, required training, certification, licensing, relicensing and funding options for emergency response services, fire departments or independent services, service levels, geographical limitations and other factors; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the secretary of health, the chief of the emergency medical systems bureau of the department of health, the executive director of New Mexico counties and the executive director of the New Mexico municipal league.
