11	PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE 8 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF NEW
12	MEXICO TO REQUIRE AN EXEMPTION FROM PROPERTY TAXATION FOR A

17	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	SECTION 1. It is proposed to amend Article 8 of the
19	constitution of New Mexico by adding a new section to read:
20	"A. The legislature shall exempt from taxation the
21	residential property, including the community or joint property
22	of married individuals, of a person who is seventy-five years
23	of age or older, who occupies the property as the person's
24	principal place of residence and who has an annual household
25	income of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) or less, adjusted
