SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENT number \_\_\_\_\_ to SENATE BILL 116

Amendment sponsored by Senator William E. Sharer

1. On page 1, line 13, after the semicolon, insert "PROVIDING A THIRD DEGREE FELONY FOR THE INTENTIONAL REVEAL OF TAXPAYER INFORMATION;".

2. On page 6, between lines 4 and 5, insert the following new section:

"SECTION 2. Section 7-1-76 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1965, Chapter 248, Section 76, as amended) is amended to read:

"7-1-76. MISDEMEANOR PENALTY FOR REVEALING INFORMATION CONCERNING TAXPAYERS--THIRD DEGREE FELONY FOR INTENTIONAL REVEAL.--

A. Except as provided in Subsection B of this section, a person who reveals to another person any return or return information that is prohibited from being revealed pursuant to Section 7-1-8 NMSA 1978 or who uses a return or return information for any purpose that is not authorized by Sections 7-1-8 through 7-1-8.11 NMSA 1978 is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or imprisoned up to one year, or both, together with costs of prosecution, and shall not be employed by the state for a period of five years after the date of the conviction.

B. A person who intentionally reveals to another person any return or return information that is prohibited from being revealed pursuant to Section 7-1-8 NMSA 1978 is guilty of a third degree felony and shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or imprisoned up to three years, or both, together with costs of prosecution, and shall never again

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be employed by the state.".

3. Renumber the succeeding section accordingly.
