SECTION 1. Section 29-2-21 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1941, Chapter 147, Section 20, as amended) is amended to read: "29-2-21. DETAILS.--

A. The governor [of New Mexico] may from time to time detail all or any part of the [New Mexico] state police to such part of the state as in [his] the governor's judgment may be necessary to bring about proper law enforcement in the state to handle disturbances or to investigate specific law violations.
