20	SECTION 1. It is proposed to amend Article 8 of the
21	constitution of New Mexico by adding a new section to read:
22	"The legislature shall exempt up to one hundred percent of
23	the taxable value of residential property subject to property
24	taxation used as the primary residence of a New Mexico resident
25	who has owned the property for at least fifteen consecutive

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years, who is age seventy years or older and whose modified 1 gross income, as determined by law, is thirty-four thousand 2 dollars (\$34,000) or less. The exemption shall be allowed in 3 the following percentages of taxable value: 4 for a person who is seventy years of age or Α. 5 older but less than seventy-five years, fifty percent; 6 Β. for a person who is seventy-five years of age or 7 older but less than eighty years, seventy-five percent; and 8 for a person who is eighty years of age or С. 9 older, one hundred percent." 10 SECTION 2.
