BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the SHPAC → **early childhood education and care** ← SHPAC department
