AN ACT

RELATING TO ENERGY; REQUIRING FACILITIES CONSTRUCTED FOR NEW AND REPLACEMENT ENERGY GENERATION CAPACITY TO GENERATE CLEAN ENERGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the Public Utility Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] NEW AND REPLACEMENT ENERGY GENERATION
CAPACITY--CLEAN ENERGY.--

- A. Facilities constructed for new or replacement energy generation capacity shall only generate clean energy.
- B. For the purposes of this section, "clean energy" means energy generated from solar heat, solar light, wind, geothermal reservoirs, carbon capture gas, biomass or hydropower.
