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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	SECTION 1. Section 24-1-10 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1973,
18	Chapter 359, Section 10) is amended to read:
19	"24-1-10. PREGNANCYSEROLOGICAL TEST FOR SYPHILIS
20	A. Every physician examining a pregnant woman for
21	conditions relating to her pregnancy [during the period of
22	gestation or at delivery or both shall take or cause to be
23	taken a sample of blood of such woman at the time of first
24	examination] shall take laboratory samples during pregnancy and
25	at delivery pursuant to syphilis testing guidelines recommended
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	1	by the federal centers for disease control and prevention.
	2	[B. All such blood samples shall be submitted to
	3	the state public health laboratory for a standard serological
	4	test for syphilis.
	5	G_{\bullet}] B. The standard serological test shall be a
	6	test [for syphilis approved by the director of the department.
	7	Such serological tests shall be made on request without charge
	8	by the department] recommended by the federal centers for
	9	disease control and prevention for the diagnosis and clinical
	10	staging of syphilis."
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
