A new section of the Criminal Code is enacted 16 to read: 17 "[NEW MATERIAL] LOOTING--PENALTY.--18 Looting consists of knowingly and without 19 authority of law or consent of the owner: 20 entering any home or dwelling or any 21 commercial business or property in which normal security of 22 property is unavailable because of fire, natural disaster, 23 riot, mob or other man-made disaster or emergency; and 24 obtaining or exerting control over or (2) 25 damaging or removing property of the owner.

B. Whoever commits looting is guilty of a fourth degree felony and shall be sentenced pursuant to the provisions of Section 31-18-15 NMSA 1978. Regardless of whether a court imposes a sentence of imprisonment pursuant to Section 31-18-15 NMSA 1978 or suspends or defers imprisonment pursuant to the provisions of Section 31-20-3 NMSA 1978, the court shall impose a sentence of at least one hundred hours of community service as determined by the court and shall require the defendant to make restitution, pursuant to Section 31-17-1 NMSA 1978, to the owner of the property looted."

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
