B. When making transportation distribution payments
to school districts and state-chartered charter schools, the
department shall ensure that appropriate amounts are
distributed to pay each school bus driver, whether driving for
a school district-owned bus operation, a state-chartered
charter school or a school bus contractor, the daily salary
mandated in Subsection A of this section.

C. A school district or a state-chartered charter school shall pay a school bus contractor the appropriate gross receipts tax on payments the contractor receives for those contract services that do not include school bus driving for which drivers are paid the salary mandated in Subsection A of this section."

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
