AN ACT

RELATING TO LICENSE PLATES; CREATING A NEW MEXICO MINERS SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the Motor Vehicle Code is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] NEW MEXICO MINERS SPECIAL REGISTRATION
PLATE.--

- A. The division shall issue a standardized special registration plate with a logo as specified in Section 66-3-424 NMSA 1978 commemorating New Mexico miners.
- B. For a fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00), which fee shall be in addition to the regular motor vehicle registration fees, the owner of a vehicle may apply for issuance of a New Mexico miners special registration plate. The owner shall .219251.1

apply for and pay the fee each year to retain and renew the New Mexico miners special registration plate.

- C. Revenue from the additional fee for a New Mexico miners special registration plate shall be distributed as follows:
- (1) ten dollars (\$10.00) of the fee collected for each registration plate shall be retained by the department and is appropriated to the department for the manufacture and issuance of the special registration plates; and
- (2) ten dollars (\$10.00) of the fee collected shall be distributed to the miners' hospital of New Mexico to be used for chronic illness research."

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2021.
