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A MEMORIAL

DECLARING MARCH 17, 2021 "4-H DAY" IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

WHEREAS, 4-H is the largest youth organization in the world with seven million youth members and six hundred three thousand volunteer leaders; and

WHEREAS, 4-H has been a premier youth leadership organization in New Mexico for more than one hundred years; and

WHEREAS, 4-H sponsors clubs in rural and urban areas throughout the state; and

WHEREAS, traditionally, thirty thousand youths between the ages of five and eighteen participate in 4-H youth development programs statewide; and

WHEREAS, traditionally, three thousand volunteers aid 4-H youth development programs, and more than two hundred projects are available in New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, 4-H youth development programs are diverse and help participants acquire important life skills, including leadership, responsible citizenship, critical thinking, problem-solving, decision-making, conflict resolution and communication skills, that directly contribute to the successful transition of young people into productive adults; and

2 confidence and a more positive self-identity, stating that
3 they have greater control over events in their lives and a
4 better ability to make decisions on their own, that they set
5 goals and take responsibility for their actions, that they
6 can take pride in many things and that their lives have
7 purpose and meaning; and

8 WHEREAS, 4-H projects are offered in creative arts,
9 health and nutrition, natural science, plants and animals,
10 communications and many more areas; and

11 WHEREAS, the objective of 4-H is to teach members how to
12 think, not what to think;

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
14 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that, in
15 recognition of the contributions of 4-H to the state, March
16 17, 2021 be declared "4-H Day" in the house of
17 representatives; and

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be
19 transmitted to New Mexico state university's 4-H youth
