17	"10-7-9. MINIMUM SALARY RATE
18	<u>A.</u> Every [state employee and every] person
19	regularly employed at a state educational institution named in
20	Article 12, Section 11 of the constitution of New Mexico
21	[constitution], except student employees as defined by the
22	[board of educational finance] higher education department,
23	shall receive a salary at a rate equal to at least four hundred
24	dollars (\$400) per month.
