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1 impact" means the impact on a governmental entity by virtue of 2 the governmental entity: (1) making a payment of anything of value to a 3 4 private entity or promising to make a payment of anything of 5 value to a private entity; or 6 (2) forgiving a tax or other liability owed to 7 the governmental entity by a private entity or promising to 8 forgive a tax or other liability owed to the governmental 9 entity by a private entity. 10 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred thousand dollars 11 (\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board 12 of regents of the university of New Mexico for expenditure in 13 fiscal year 2023 for the bureau of business and economic 14 research to evaluate the fiscal impact on state and local 15 governments of the proposed Santolina development in Bernalillo 16 county.
