

SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL 213

55TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - SECOND SESSION, 2022

AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; REAUTHORIZING OR
REAPPROPRIATING BALANCES, EXPANDING OR CHANGING PURPOSES,
EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIODS, CHANGING AGENCIES AND
ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE REVERSION OR TRANSFER OF
UNEXPENDED BALANCES OF APPROPRIATIONS MADE BY THE LEGISLATURE
IN PRIOR YEARS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--REVERSION OF PROCEEDS.--

A. Except as otherwise provided in another section
of this act:

(1) the unexpended balance from the proceeds
of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been
reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax
bonding fund:

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1 (a) at the end of the expenditure period
2 as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is changed
3 in this act; or

4 (b) if the expenditure period is not
5 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in
6 the law that originally authorized the severance tax bonds or
7 the time frame set forth in any law that has previously
8 reauthorized the expenditure of the proceeds, whichever is
9 later; and

10 (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds
11 of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been
12 reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax
13 bonding fund three months after the reversion date for the
14 unexpended balances.

15 B. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
16 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
17 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
18 written obligations to third parties.

19 SECTION 2. GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUND APPROPRIATIONS--
20 REVERSIONS.--

21 A. Except as otherwise provided in another section
22 of this act:

23 (1) the unexpended balance of an appropriation
24 from the general fund or other state fund that has been changed
25 in this act shall revert:

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1 (a) at the end of the expenditure period
2 as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is changed
3 in this act; or

4 (b) if the expenditure period is not
5 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in
6 the law in which the original appropriation was made or the
7 time frame set forth in any law that has previously changed the
8 appropriation, whichever is later; and

9 (2) all remaining balances of an appropriation
10 from the general fund or other state fund that has been changed
11 in this act shall revert three months after the reversion date
12 for the unexpended balance.

13 B. Except as provided in Subsection C of this
14 section, the balance of an appropriation made from the general
15 fund or other state fund shall revert pursuant to Subsection A
16 of this section to the originating fund.

17 C. The balance of an appropriation made from the
18 general fund or other state fund to the Indian affairs
19 department or the aging and long-term services department for a
20 project located on lands of an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo
21 shall revert pursuant to Subsection A of this section to the
22 tribal infrastructure project fund.

23 D. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
24 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
25 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding

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1 written obligations to third parties.

2 **SECTION 3. PASEO DEL VOLCAN LOOP BYPASS ROAD**
3 CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO PASEO DEL VOLCAN CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND
4 TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the
5 appropriation to the department of transportation originally
6 authorized in Subsection 57 of Section 25 of Chapter 66 of Laws
7 2014 to acquire rights of way for and to plan, design and
8 construct paseo del Volcan loop bypass road from Unser
9 boulevard to interstate 40 in Bernalillo and Sandoval counties
10 and reauthorized in Laws 2018, Chapter 68, Section 3 and for
11 which the time of expenditure was extended in Laws 2020,
12 Chapter 82, Section 3 shall not be expended for the original
13 purpose but is changed to acquire rights of way for and to
14 plan, design and construct paseo del Volcan in Bernalillo and
15 Sandoval counties. The time of expenditure is extended through
16 fiscal year 2024.

17 **SECTION 4. PASEO DEL VOLCAN CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--**
18 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the
19 department of transportation project in Subsection 1 of Section
20 32 of Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to acquire rights of way and to
21 design and construct paseo del Volcan, also known as New Mexico
22 highway 347, in Sandoval and Bernalillo counties is extended
23 through fiscal year 2024.

24 **SECTION 5. PASEO DEL VOLCAN RIGHTS OF WAY ACQUISITION AND**
25 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of

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1 expenditure for the department of transportation project in
 2 Subsection 1 of Section 24 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to
 3 acquire rights of way and to design and construct paseo del
 4 Volcan, also known as New Mexico highway 347, in Sandoval and
 5 Bernalillo counties and for which the time of expenditure was
 6 extended in Laws 2020, Chapter 82, Section 4 is extended
 7 through fiscal year 2024.

8 **SECTION 6. PASEO DEL VOLCAN RIGHTS OF WAY ACQUISITION--**
 9 **CHANGE TO PASEO DEL VOLCAN CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE**
 10 **TAX BONDS.--**The unexpended balance of the appropriation to the
 11 department of transportation in Subsection 61 of Section 24 of
 12 Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to purchase rights of way for paseo del
 13 Volcan from Unser boulevard to the Bernalillo-Sandoval county
 14 line and for which the time of expenditure was extended in Laws
 15 2020, Chapter 82, Section 79 shall not be expended for the
 16 original purpose but is changed to acquire rights of way and to
 17 plan, design and construct paseo del Volcan in Bernalillo and
 18 Sandoval counties. The time of expenditure is extended through
 19 fiscal year 2024.

20 **SECTION 7. ATRISCO HERITAGE ACADEMY HIGH SCHOOL ACCESS**
 21 **ROAD CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time
 22 of expenditure for the department of transportation project
 23 originally authorized in Subsection 7 of Section 24 of Chapter
 24 81 of Laws 2016 to plan, design and construct an access road to
 25 Atrisco Heritage academy high school, including driveways,

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1 trail connections and modifications to Senator Dennis Chavez
2 boulevard and to 118th street, in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
3 county and reauthorized in Laws 2020, Chapter 82, Section 16 to
4 include sidewalks and signal modifications is extended through
5 fiscal year 2024.

6 SECTION 8. BERNALILLO COUNTY FAMILY SERVICES FACILITIES
7 IMPROVEMENT--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
8 expenditure for the local government division project in
9 Subsection 53 of Section 26 of Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to plan,
10 design and construct renovations and improvements to the
11 buildings and grounds of a child development and family
12 services facility site in the South Valley in Bernalillo county
13 and to purchase and install teleconferencing and information
14 technology equipment at facility sites in the South Valley and
15 the southeast heights in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is
16 extended through fiscal year 2024.

17 SECTION 9. BERNALILLO COUNTY HOMELESS FACILITY SHOWERS
18 AND LAUNDRY CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS--
19 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the
20 appropriation to the local government division project in
21 Subsection 7 of Section 29 of Chapter 138 of Laws 2021 to plan,
22 design, construct, purchase, furnish, equip and install
23 accessible showers and laundry services for a facility serving
24 the homeless in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the
25 original purpose but is changed to plan, design, purchase,

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1 install, equip and furnish a facility, including information
2 technology and related furniture, equipment and infrastructure,
3 white goods and vehicles, for an agency providing services to
4 the homeless in Bernalillo county.

5 SECTION 10. BERNALILLO COUNTY MULTI-USE INDOOR SPORTS
6 FACILITY--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
7 expenditure for the local government division project in
8 Subsection 7 of Section 26 of Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to plan,
9 design, construct, equip and furnish a multi-use indoor sports
10 facility in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year
11 2024.

12 SECTION 11. INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL AT MESA DEL SOL
13 IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
14 expenditure for the public education department project in
15 Subsection 8 of Section 16 of Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to plan,
16 design, construct, renovate, furnish and equip buildings,
17 grounds and physical education changing rooms, including the
18 purchase and installation of related equipment, fencing,
19 information technology, wiring, paving and infrastructure, for
20 the international school at Mesa del Sol charter school in
21 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2024.

22 SECTION 12. ISLETA BOULEVARD SOUTHWEST IMPROVEMENTS--
23 EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for
24 the department of transportation project in Subsection 5 of
25 Section 32 of Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to design and construct

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1 improvements to Isleta boulevard from Muniz road SW to United
2 States interstate highway 25 in Bernalillo county is extended
3 through fiscal year 2024.

4 SECTION 13. ALBUQUERQUE SIGN LANGUAGE ACADEMY FACILITY
5 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
6 expenditure for the public education department project in
7 Subsection 3 of Section 16 of Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to plan,
8 design and construct a facility for the Albuquerque sign
9 language academy in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is
10 extended through fiscal year 2024.

11 SECTION 14. TWENTY-FIRST CENTURY PUBLIC ACADEMY CHARTER
12 SCHOOL HEATING, VENTILATION AND AIR CONDITIONING SYSTEM
13 IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of
14 expenditure for the public education department project
15 originally authorized in Subsection 27 of Section 63 of Chapter
16 81 of Laws 2020 and reauthorized in Laws 2021, Chapter 139,
17 Section 11 to plan, design, construct, renovate, furnish and
18 equip buildings and grounds and to purchase and install
19 heating, ventilation and air conditioning and air filtration
20 systems and related equipment and to purchase and install
21 information technology, including related equipment, furniture
22 and infrastructure, and for wiring and fencing for the Twenty-
23 First Century public academy charter school in Albuquerque in
24 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2024.

25 SECTION 15. ALBUQUERQUE COLLEGIATE CHARTER SCHOOL

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1 SECURITY SYSTEMS PURCHASE--EXPAND PURPOSE--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL
2 FUND.--The public education department project in Subsection 9
3 of Section 63 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to equip and install a
4 security system and related infrastructure and equipment for
5 the Albuquerque Collegiate charter school in Albuquerque in
6 Bernalillo county may include the purchase and installation of
7 security cameras. The time of expenditure is extended through
8 fiscal year 2024.

9 SECTION 16. ALBUQUERQUE CRESTVIEW BLUFF OPEN SPACE
10 ACQUISITION--CHANGE TO ALBUQUERQUE CRESTVIEW BLUFF PARKS AND
11 TRAILS--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the
12 appropriation to the local government division in Subsection 34
13 of Section 29 of Chapter 138 of Laws 2021 to acquire property
14 for and to plan, design, construct and equip the Crestview
15 bluff open space area in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall
16 not be expended for the original purpose but is changed to
17 acquire property for and to plan, design, construct and equip
18 the Crestview bluff open space area, parks and trails in
19 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county.

20 SECTION 17. BERNALILLO COUNTY CRESTVIEW BLUFFS PURCHASE--
21 CHANGE TO ALBUQUERQUE CRESTVIEW BLUFF OPEN SPACE AREA, PARKS
22 AND TRAILS CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The
23 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the local government
24 division in Subsection 5 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws
25 2019 to acquire property for a Crestview bluffs open space area
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1 and to match funds for a national park service land and water
2 conservation fund grant for the purchase of Crestview bluffs in
3 Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the original
4 purpose but is changed to acquire property for and to plan,
5 design, construct and equip an open space area, parks and
6 trails in the Crestview bluff area in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
7 county. The time of expenditure is extended through fiscal
8 year 2024.

9 **SECTION 18. ALBUQUERQUE CRESTVIEW BLUFF GREEN SPACE**
10 **CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO OPEN SPACE, PARKS AND TRAILS**
11 **CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--**The unexpended
12 balance of the appropriation to the local government division
13 in Subsection 43 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to
14 acquire property and to plan, design and construct an urban
15 green space along the Crestview bluff area off the Arenal drain
16 from west central avenue to Bridge boulevard both within and
17 outside the city limits of Albuquerque in Bernalillo county
18 shall not be expended for the original purpose but is changed
19 to acquire property for and to plan, design, construct and
20 equip the Crestview bluff open space area, parks and trails in
21 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county. The time of expenditure is
22 extended through fiscal year 2024.

23 **SECTION 19. ALBUQUERQUE RADIO COMMUNICATIONS BUREAU**
24 **BUILDING CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY**
25 **ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLEX CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE AGENCY--SEVERANCE**

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1 TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the appropriation to the
2 department of information technology in Subsection 1 of Section
3 31 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to plan, design, construct,
4 renovate, furnish and equip a building for the Albuquerque
5 radio communications bureau in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county
6 shall not be expended for the original purpose but is
7 appropriated to the capital program fund to acquire land for
8 and to plan, design, construct, furnish and equip an
9 administrative complex for the department of public safety in
10 Albuquerque.

11 SECTION 20. ALBUQUERQUE DISPATCH AND RECORDS MANAGEMENT
12 SYSTEM--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
13 expenditure for the local government division project in
14 Subsection 53 of Section 35 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to
15 upgrade the computer-aided dispatch and records management
16 system for the Albuquerque police department in Bernalillo
17 county is extended through fiscal year 2024.

18 SECTION 21. ALBUQUERQUE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE SHELTER
19 COTTAGES RENOVATION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The
20 time of expenditure for the local government division project
21 in Subsection 54 of Section 35 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to
22 plan, design and construct renovations in cottages for victims
23 of domestic abuse, including additional entries and bathrooms,
24 in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
25 year 2024.

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1 **SECTION 22. ALBUQUERQUE FIRE RESCUE COMMUNICATIONS AND**
2 **DISPATCH EQUIPMENT PURCHASE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX**
3 **BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for the local government
4 division project in Subsection 59 of Section 35 of Chapter 81
5 of Laws 2020 to purchase and equip fire communications and
6 dispatch equipment for Albuquerque fire rescue in Albuquerque
7 in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2024.

8 **SECTION 23. ALBUQUERQUE FIRE RESPONSE BRUSH TRUCK**
9 **PURCHASE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of
10 expenditure for the local government division project in
11 Subsection 60 of Section 35 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to
12 purchase and equip a brush truck for the city of Albuquerque in
13 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2024.

14 **SECTION 24. ALBUQUERQUE PAT HURLEY PARK AND COMMUNITY**
15 **CENTER IMPROVEMENTS--CHANGE TO IMPROVEMENTS TO THE JOAN JONES**
16 **COMMUNITY CENTER--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The
17 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the local government
18 division in Subsection 36 of Section 26 of Chapter 80 of Laws
19 2018 to plan, design, construct, expand, renovate, purchase and
20 install phase 2 improvements to the Pat Hurley park and
21 community center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not
22 be expended for the original purpose but is changed to plan,
23 design, construct, expand, equip and furnish phase 2
24 improvements to the Joan Jones community center in Albuquerque.
25 The time of expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2024.

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1 **SECTION 25. ALBUQUERQUE JUAN TABO HILLS FIRE STATION LAND**
2 ACQUISITION, CONSTRUCTION AND IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--
3 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the local
4 government division project in Subsection 26 of Section 26 of
5 Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to acquire land and rights of way and
6 to plan, design, construct, renovate, upgrade and equip phase 1
7 of a fire station in the Juan Tabo Hills area of southeast
8 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
9 year 2024.

10 **SECTION 26. ALBUQUERQUE POLICE DEPARTMENT CRIME SCENE**
11 VEHICLE PURCHASE--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of
12 expenditure for the local government division project in
13 Subsection 11 of Section 72 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to
14 purchase and equip a crime scene response vehicle for the
15 police department in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is
16 extended through fiscal year 2024.

17 **SECTION 27. ALBUQUERQUE POLICE DEPARTMENT TECHNOLOGY**
18 MODERNIZATION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
19 expenditure for the local government division project in
20 Subsection 103 of Section 35 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to
21 purchase and equip video management system information
22 technology, including automated license plate readers, for the
23 Albuquerque police department in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
24 county is extended through fiscal year 2024.

25 **SECTION 28. RIO RANCHO PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT ROBOTICS**

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1 PROGRAM EQUIPMENT--CHANGE AGENCY--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX
2 BONDS.--The public education department project in Subsection
3 167 of Section 17 of Chapter 138 of Laws 2021 to purchase,
4 improve and install equipment and furnishings, including
5 information technology, for a robotics program to assist youth
6 in science, technology, engineering and mathematics in Rio
7 Rancho in Sandoval county is appropriated to the local
8 government division for that purpose. The time of expenditure
9 is extended through fiscal year 2024.

10 SECTION 29. ALBUQUERQUE SOUTHEAST/MID-HEIGHTS PARK
11 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
12 expenditure for the local government division project in
13 Subsection 45 of Section 26 of Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to
14 acquire land for and to plan, design and construct a park
15 facility in the southeast and mid-heights area of Albuquerque
16 in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2024.

17 SECTION 30. ALBUQUERQUE WEST CENTRAL REDEVELOPMENT
18 DISTRICT INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE
19 TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the local government
20 division project in Subsection 50 of Section 26 of Chapter 80
21 of Laws 2018 to acquire land for and to plan, design and
22 construct infrastructure improvements in the west Central
23 avenue area for the west Central metropolitan redevelopment
24 district in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended
25 through fiscal year 2024.

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1 **SECTION 31. ALBUQUERQUE WOMEN'S MEMORIAL PARK**

2 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
3 expenditure for the local government division project in
4 Subsection 51 of Section 26 of Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to
5 construct a women's memorial park at Amole Mesa avenue and
6 118th street in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended
7 through fiscal year 2024.

8 **SECTION 32. BERNALILLO COUNTY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROGRAM**

9 PLAYGROUND AND VEHICLE EQUIPMENT--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL
10 FUND.--The time of expenditure for the local government
11 division project in Subsection 2 of Section 72 of Chapter 81 of
12 Laws 2020 to purchase and install a portable playground, to
13 purchase and equip a vehicle and to purchase and install
14 information technology equipment for behavioral health and
15 forensic interview programs in Bernalillo county is extended
16 through fiscal year 2024.

17 **SECTION 33. BERNALILLO COUNTY INDUSTRIAL TRANSLOAD**

18 FACILITY ROAD IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX
19 BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the department of
20 transportation project in Subsection 4 of Section 32 of Chapter
21 80 of Laws 2018 to plan, design, construct and improve roads
22 and drainage for an industrial park and transload facility in
23 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2024.

24 **SECTION 34. BERNALILLO COUNTY TRANSITIONAL LIVING**

25 FACILITY IMPROVEMENT--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The
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1 time of expenditure for the local government division project
2 in Subsection 54 of Section 26 of Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to
3 plan, design and renovate buildings, including interior and
4 exterior finish work, replacement of roof and building systems,
5 the purchase and installation of security cameras and a
6 security system and improvements to the parking lot and
7 landscaping, at a transitional living center in Albuquerque in
8 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2024.

9 SECTION 35. EL CAMINO REAL ACADEMY CHARTER SCHOOL
10 BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS RENOVATION--EXPAND PURPOSE--EXTEND TIME--
11 GENERAL FUND.--The public education department project in
12 Subsection 15 of Section 63 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to
13 purchase security fencing, including related equipment, for El
14 Camino Real academy charter school in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
15 county may include the purchase and installation of security
16 camera systems. The time of expenditure is extended through
17 fiscal year 2024.

18 SECTION 36. GILBERT L. SENA CHARTER HIGH SCHOOL
19 IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
20 expenditure for the public education department project in
21 Subsection 7 of Section 16 of Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to plan,
22 design, construct, renovate, furnish and equip buildings and
23 grounds, including the installation of a science lab and the
24 installation of related equipment, fencing, information
25 technology, wiring and infrastructure, for the Gilbert L. Sena

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1 charter school in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended
2 through fiscal year 2024.

3 **SECTION 37. HEALTH LEADERSHIP HIGH SCHOOL CHARTER SCHOOL**
4 **BUILDING AND GROUNDS CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL**
5 **FUND.--**The time of expenditure for the public education
6 department project in Subsection 84 of Section 63 of Chapter 81
7 of Laws 2020 to acquire, equip and install security equipment,
8 fencing and related infrastructure and equipment for the Health
9 Leadership high school charter school in the Albuquerque public
10 school district in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
11 year 2024.

12 **SECTION 38. LADERA ROAD NORTHWEST IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND**
