2	AMENDING THE SENATE RULES FOR ANY SESSION OF THE FIFTY-FIFTH		
3	LEGISLATURE HELD IN 2022.		
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5	WHEREAS, Senate Rule 24-1 provides that the rules of the		
6	senate may be amended by a two-thirds' majority vote of the		
7	members of the senate or by a majority vote of the members of		
8	the senate upon the recommendation of the senate rules		
9	committee;		
10	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE		
11	STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the following new senate rules, for		
12	any session of the fifty-fifth legislature held in 2022, be		
13	adopted to read:		
14	"2-4 Each senator may permit staff responsible to that		
15	senator to perform assigned duties from within the		
16	capitol or from a remote location; provided that a		
17	staff member required to isolate in accordance with		
18	federal centers for disease control and prevention		
19	guidelines shall follow those guidelines."; and		
20	"4-1-1 If the federal centers for disease control and		
21	prevention recommends masking in public places, the		
22	presiding officer shall ensure that all members,		
23	staff, employees and guests who are physically		
24	present in the senate chambers wear a mask that		
25	covers the mouth and nose, pursuant to the		

recommendations of the federal centers for disease control and prevention, and not consume food in the senate chambers."; and

"6-1-1 4 If the federal centers for disease control and 5 prevention recommends masking in public places, the sergeant-at-arms shall ensure that all members, 6 staff, employees and guests who are physically 7 present in the senate gallery, senate committee 8 rooms and the senate hallways wear a mask that 9 10 covers the mouth and nose, pursuant to the recommendations of the federal centers for disease 11 control and prevention, and not consume food in 12 those areas."; and 13

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"7-1-1 A senator shall be considered to be present and in 14 15 attendance for the purposes of establishing a quorum, doing business, satisfying a call or voting 16 during a floor session if the member is physically 17 present or participating by simultaneous, remote 18 electronic means, from within the capitol, as 19 verified by the sergeant-at-arms. If a call is 20 satisfied, members within the capitol shall 21 participate during the debate from the floor or the 22 member's capitol office and vote on the issue that 23 is the subject of the call."; and 24 "7-1-2 25 A senator shall be considered to be present and in

attendance for the purposes of establishing a quorum, doing business or voting during standing committee meetings if the member is physically present or participating by simultaneous, remote electronic means and is visually present, or if participating by telephone, is confirmed to be present by voice, as confirmed by the committee chair, from within the capitol."; and "7-1-3 A senator who is required to isolate or quarantine as provided by the guidance of the federal centers for disease control and prevention may continue to participate via simultaneous, remote electronic means from outside the capitol. A senator with a medical condition that classifies the senator as having high risk for mortality from severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2, as defined by the federal centers for disease control and prevention, may participate via simultaneous, remote electronic means from outside the capitol upon providing to the senator's respective floor leader or the president pro tempore documentation from a physician, nurse practitioner or other advanced practice medical professional licensed in New Mexico verifying the underlying condition. In the event of a call of the senate, members

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participating remotely from outside the capitol who have not been excused or necessarily prevented from being present shall be considered present for the purposes of the call. If a call is satisfied, members participating remotely who are considered present shall participate during the debate and vote on the issue that is the subject of the call."; and

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"7-19 Members of the senate, staff, employees and guests 9 10 shall wear face masks or respirators, as recommended by the federal centers for disease 11 control and prevention, covering the mouth and nose 12 when physically present in the senate chamber, 13 galleries, lobby, senate committee rooms and rooms 14 15 connected therewith. Failure to do so shall constitute a violation of these rules, and 16 violators are subject to disciplinary action and 17 removal from the chamber or committee room. 18 Α senator who is not compliant with this rule in the 19 senate chamber or committee room may participate 20 remotely from the member's office."; and 21 "7-20 Legislators participating via simultaneous, remote 22 electronic means on the senate floor or in any 23 senate standing committee shall be visually 24 present. A legislator who is not visually present 25

1 when called upon shall be listed as absent, unless No legislator shall be logged in to a 2 excused. 3 senate committee while simultaneously logged in or present in any other legislative committee meeting 4 5 or floor session, nor shall a senator be simultaneously logged in to be present on the 6 senate floor and in a senate committee."; and 7 8 "9-5-9 Meetings shall be staffed by one or more hosts to facilitate and allow participation by the committee 9 10 members, expert witnesses and the public. The chair, in consultation with the ranking member, may 11 determine the duration of public comment allowed. 12 Each standing committee may also receive public 13 comment by email."; and 14 "22-3 15 Courtesy memorials and certificates shall not be read aloud on the senate floor."; and 16 "23-14 The president pro tempore may set occupancy limits 17 for any of the space occupied by senate committees 18 and corresponding hallways and may reassign 19 20 committee rooms and the senate floor as necessary to enable sufficient social distancing for members, 21 staff and the public."; and 22 "24-3 In the event of a public health emergency while the 23 senate is in session, the senate shall adhere to 24 health guidelines as outlined by the federal 25

centers for disease control and prevention and as maintained on the legislature's website for the senate when the senate is in session."; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following senate rules be amended to read:

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"7-18 Members of the senate shall dress in business 6 7 attire befitting the decorum of the senate and the wearing of bolo ties shall be permitted, regardless 8 of whether the member is participating in person or 9 10 via simultaneous, remote electronic means. All persons permitted access to the floor of the senate 11 shall be held to the same standard."; and 12 "9-1-2 13 In appointing the standing committees, the committees' committee shall designate the chair, 14 15 vice chair and the ranking member who shall be a member of the committee and who does not hold a 16 leadership position in either caucus or the 17 chamber. The ranking member of a standing 18 committee shall not be of the same political party 19 as the chair. In designating the chair, vice chair 20 or ranking member, the committees' committee shall 21 consider the preference of each member's respective 22 leader. No member designated to serve as the chair 23 of a standing committee shall serve as chair on any 24 other committee; provided that no vice chair of the SRC/SR 1 25 Page 6
