Synopsis of Joint Memorial

House Joint Memorial 3 requests New Mexico legislative council implement a policy requiring all interim committees adopt the provisions of the Open Meetings Acts (Section 10-15-2 NMSA 1978).

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no fiscal implications of this bill, although for some meetings which have not been made public, the committee or council may need to spend some additional time or resources to ensure the meeting is in compliance with a public meeting such as ensuring public notice has been given.

Additionally, adopting a policy may use some staff time, but it is likely minimal.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Most if not all interim meetings are already allowing for public meetings and following the Open Meeting Act.
