WHEREAS, the son of Teodolo and Escolastica Flores, Reynaldo was born in Pecos on September 29, 1933; and

WHEREAS, after graduating from Pecos high school, Reynaldo joined the United States air force; and

WHEREAS, Reynaldo served from July 1951 to January 1955 as a military police officer during the Korean conflict; and

WHEREAS, Reynaldo completed his service at Cannon air force base in Clovis; and

WHEREAS, Reynaldo married Flora Algien on August 18, 1956, and together they raised five children: Donna, Michael,
