A RESOLUTION  
AMENDING THE HOUSE RULES REGARDING ADVANCE NOTICE OF  
LEGISLATION TO BE HEARD IN COMMITTEE AND FOR THIRD READING.

WHEREAS, House Rule 24-1 provides that the rules of the  
house of representatives may be amended by a two-thirds' vote  
of all the members of the house or by a majority vote of the  
members of the house upon the recommendation of the house rules  
and order of business committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF  
REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the following  
new House Rule 9-11-1 be enacted to read:

"9-11-1 Committee chairs shall notify the house forty-eight  
hours before a bill or resolution is to be heard in  
their respective committees. This requirement shall  
not apply to the last eight days of a session."; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following house rule be  
2 amended to read:

3 "11-20-1 When a bill, resolution or memorial is reported by a  
4 committee recommending passage and if the report is  
5 adopted by the house, all amendments offered by the  
6 committee shall be deemed amendments to the bill,  
7 resolution or memorial, and it shall be placed on  
8 the speaker's table for [~~twenty-four hours~~] one  
9 calendar day. Upon the expiration of [~~twenty-four~~  
10 ~~hours~~] one calendar day, the bill, resolution or  
11 memorial shall be placed on the calendar to be taken  
12 up on third reading in its regular order; provided,  
13 however, that the automatic placing of each bill,  
14 resolution or memorial on the speaker's table for  
15 [~~twenty-four hours~~] one calendar day shall not apply  
16 during the last eight legislative days of any  
17 session, nor at any time during a special or  
18 extraordinary session, and shall not apply to the  
19 placing of bills, resolutions and memorials on the  
20 consent calendar. Prior to third reading of bills  
21 on the calendar, the speaker shall notify the house  
22 at least twenty-four hours in advance which bills on  
23 the calendar will be considered for third reading  
24 during the next calendar day during which the house  
25 will be in session."
