- 1. On page 1, line 14, after "DEFINITIONS;", insert "REVISING THE DEFINITION OF "REQUIRED VOTER IDENTIFICATION";".
- 2. On page 7, between lines 16 and 17, insert the following new section:
- "SECTION 6. Section 1-1-24 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2005, Chapter 270, Section 6, as amended) is amended to read:
- "1-1-24. REQUIRED VOTER IDENTIFICATION.--As used in the Election Code, "required voter identification" means [any of the following forms of identification as chosen by the voter:
  - A.] a physical form of identification [which may be:
- (1) an original or copy of a current and valid photo identification with or without an address, which address is not required to match the voter's certificate of registration; or] that is issued by the federal government, a state government, a federally recognized Indian nation, tribe or pueblo or an educational institution and that:
- A. contains the name of the qualified elector, which shall reasonably match the name provided on the certificate of registration;
- B. contains a photograph of the qualified elector, which shall resemble the qualified elector;
- C. need not contain an expiration date, and if it does, the expiration date is not required to be a date on or after the
