15	SECTION 1. A new section of the Criminal Sentencing Act
16	is enacted to read:
17	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] POSSESSION OF FENTANYLENHANCED
18	SENTENCEWhen a separate finding of fact by the court or a
19	jury shows that fentanyl was possessed pursuant to Subsection A
20	of Section 30-31-23 NMSA 1978, the basic sentence of
21	imprisonment prescribed for the offense in Section 31-18-15
22	NMSA 1978 shall be enhanced when the fentanyl possessed is:
23	A. between twenty-five and forty-nine pills or in
24	any form equaling fifty to ninety milligrams of fentanyl, the
25	sentence imposed shall be increased by three years;
