The "judicial education center" is created at 15 the institute of public law at the university of New Mexico law 16 school. 17 **B.**] The judicial education [center] services 18 division of the administrative office of the courts shall 19 provide judicial education, training and instruction for the 20 justices, judges, magistrates and court personnel of the state, 21 municipalities and counties and may provide such education for 22 tribal judges." 23 **SECTION 3.** APPROPRIATION. -- Two million one hundred 24 fourteen thousand one hundred dollars (\$2,114,100) is 25 appropriated from the general fund to the judicial education
