- (3) display two aviation orange spherical markers on each outer guy wire, if applicable, that are at least twenty inches in diameter;
- display two high-visibility sleeves on (4) each outer guy wire, if applicable; and
- comply with any applicable county and (5) municipal standards.
- The aviation division of the department of transportation shall adopt rules to create a registry of meteorological evaluation towers in the state and require a person who owns, operates or erects a meteorological evaluation tower to provide notice to the aviation division of the existence of or intent to erect a meteorological evaluation tower.
- A person who owns, operates or erects a С. meteorological evaluation tower in violation of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable pursuant to Section 31-19-1 NMSA 1978.
- A meteorological evaluation tower erected before July 1, 2023, shall be in compliance with the provisions of this section by January 1, 2024.
- As used in this section, "meteorological evaluation tower":
 - means a structure that:

feet in diameter; and								
(c)	is associated with the development							

or study of wind-powered electric generation, commonly known as a "MET tower"; and
