18	"1-1-4. QUALIFIED ELECTOR
19	A. As used in the Election Code and rules
20	promulgated by the secretary of state, "qualified elector"
21	means any resident of this state who is qualified to vote under
22	the provisions of the constitution of New Mexico and the
23	constitution of the United States and includes any [qualified]
24	resident who is at least sixteen years of age.
25	B. As used in all other statutes and rules of New
