15	SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 31 NMSA 1978 is
16	enacted to read:
17	"[ <u>NEW MATERIAL</u> ] EVALUATION AND TREATMENT FOR SUBSTANCE
18	ABUSE OR MENTAL HEALTH
19	A. Whenever, during the pendency of a criminal case
20	or after a conviction, it appears that the defendant may
21	require drug, alcohol or mental health treatment, the court
22	shall refer the defendant for an evaluation. If the evaluation
23	recommends that the defendant receive or finds that the
24	defendant requires drug, alcohol or mental health treatment,
25	the court shall order that the defendant participate in that
